Introducing our 2026 Judge

Ms Kylie Board (WA)

Hi! I'm Kylie from Western Australia and I'm honoured to be judging the rabbit section of the 2026 Sydney Royal Easter Show next year and am really looking forward to seeing everyone and their beautiful bunnies.

I'm best known for my work educating on rabbit Calicivirus and helping gather data that contributed toward vaccine approval in Australia, connecting rabbits owners from all backgrounds in Australia to come together for one goal and for gaining worldwide interest in our plight against RHDV2 whilst sharing my own struggle with losing my rabbits from the virus - work I remain incredibly proud of and continue to this day.

My judging experience began at a young age and has been shaped by learning from both visiting international judges and our talented Australian judges along with taking the time to keep and learn about all breeds, book stewarding every chance I got and asking all the weird and wonderful questions I could... which is probably why I love when people ask me those questions today!



Throughout my years in the fancy, I've worked with many breeds some include; New Zealand Whites, Chinchilla, English, Silver Fox (which also popped out Astrex), Standard Rex, Polish, Standard & Mini Satin, Tan, Dwarf Lop, Mini Lop, Mini Satin Lop, Mini Cashmere Lop, Netherland Dwarf and English Angora to name a few.



Today, I maintain a small group of Polish, Standard Satin, Tan, Mini Cashmere, my recreated English, and more recently Mini Satins. My focus is preserving rare breeds in small, sustainable lines and giving all my older rabbits a peaceful, bonded retirement for the rest of their

lives, I also adopt special needs rabbits knowing I can offer them the best life possible and give them access to the best vet care, comfy homes and spend their last years knowing I'll do anything for them (you don't even want to know how much I've spent on vet bills).

My favourite breed are the English which I've spent years recreating on a very small and slow scale - I just absolutely adore them and will talk about them any chance I get! I also love my Polish, Tans and an extinct breed in Australia - the Argente in champagne, crème and brun.

Rabbit health, ethics, and education are at the heart of everything I do, and I look forward to meeting exhibitors and of course my absolute favourite section - the pet section and supporting the community at the Sydney Royal Show!

HISTORY OF THE SYDNEY ROYAL RABBIT SHOW

Sydney Royal Rabbit Show

The Rabbit Fanciers Society of NSW Inc in conjunction with the Royal Agricultural Society of NSW Inc are both delighted to invite exhibitors Australia wide to attend the 2026 Sydney Royal Rabbit Show held on Wednesday the 8th of April 2026 at the Sydney Royal Easter Show in the pet pavilion, Sydney Showground, Sydney Olympic Park, NSW 2127.

In 1858 rabbits were judged in the poultry competition up until 1882 when the farmers of NSW decided rabbits were becoming a bit of pest, so they stopped the competition, but in 1997 rabbits came back to the show and have been leaping into the hearts of Showgoers ever since. With many issues damaging the rabbit fancy over many years, numbers dwindled from over 200 exhibits over a two-day show back in 2012, down to just 50 rabbits in a single day show in 2017.

In 2018 the Rabbit Fanciers Society of NSW took on the challenge to make the Sydney Royal Rabbit show the centerpiece of the NSW rabbit fancy and to bring it back to the premier event of the fancy again. With success in their first year, RFS managed to bring numbers back up to 166 exhibits in 2018 with judge Mr John Porritt from Victoria. Again, more success followed in 2019 with interstate exhibitors attending making up 209 entries for judge Sarah Van Steenis from Tasmania and 65 Young Stock entries for Sarah's Mother, Debbie Pulford.

In 2020 we seen the Covid pandemic hit drastically making many changes in the world including the first cancellation of the Sydney Royal Show since the Spanish flu pandemic back in 1919. The show was cancelled a month before the show was meant to start with UK judge Mr Phil Batey and 20 exhibitors entered with over 250 exhibits as well as the whole agricultural community was affected.

In 2021 we tried to bounce back with many new limitations, including interstate travel still not an option, having 144 entries for judge Mr Paul Young from NSW.

2022 brought more hope of bringing the show back to its premier level, having 213 entries for a return of judge Mr John Porritt but some scratchings mainly due to RVHD without the best vaccine available in the country.

In 2023 with Filavac vaccine in the country, it gave the future of the rabbit fancy some hope. Mr Ryan Page came from Western Australia to judge with 167 entries.

2024 was a huge success with UK judge Mr Phil Batey that we missed out on seeing back in 2020 when the show was cancelled. Phil brought a wealth of knowledge with him to share with exhibitors and many exhibitors travelled great distances to get the chance to show under Phil. There was 344 rabbits entered with a total of 264 in attendance making it the greatest rabbit show held at the Sydney Royal.

In 2025 devastation hit the fancy again with the loss of our President and appointed judge for 2025 to be Mr Rowland McDonnell, with great honour Mrs Sarah Falkner filled in and brought an entry of 173 entries. RFS introduced a perpetual trophy named the Rowland McDonnell Memorial Judges Choice Award.

We hope that all members of the rabbit fancy Australia wide will consider attending the Sydney Royal Rabbit show in 2026 bringing quantity and quality to the showpiece show of NSW making it once again the premier event for the state.

SHOW DETAILS

Date of Judging: Wednesday the 8th of April 2026.

Judge: Ms Kylie Board (WA) 5 Star Championship.

Entry Fees: Minimum entry of \$25 will be applied to each exhibitor to cover entry pass to the show (1-5 entries/classes).

Main Show 5 star: \$5 per rabbit per class.

Entries will be capped at \$80 each exhibitor (16 classes or more)

Show Manager: Loren Stavens

Vetting in: Between 6.30am and 7.30am. All exhibits must be vetted in and penned by 8.00am. Vet in opens at 6.30am please line up as you arrive.

Bump in: Delivery of exhibits between 6.30am and 8am only.

Due to venue requirements the bench slip will not permit entry into the 2026 show. To deliver exhibits during the specified delivery times, each exhibitor will need a bench slip and dash slip to permit entry for a vehicle and exhibits, and all persons inside the vehicle will need to have a valid show entry ticket to enter the site. Vehicles must be removed from site immediately after the exhibits have been delivered. Vehicles that remain on the site illegally after 8am will be infringed. All exhibitors and passengers will need a valid show entry ticket to re-enter the site on foot via the designated pedestrian entries.

Parking: Parking passes to be purchased by the exhibitor before the day of judging. Tickets must be pre purchased and printed out online for \$30 for P1, P3 and P4. Please ensure you buy your parking tickets early. www.sydneyolympicpark.com.au/parking/

Entry Passes: Maximum of Two, One day entry passes will be supplied per one to four exhibits and a maximum of three, One day entry passes per exhibitor per five or above exhibits.

Bump out: No exhibits shall leave the pavilion until 5pm unless permission is given by the show manager. Passes will be given to exhibitors to enter the pick up zone on departure.

Entries close: Saturday the 21st February 2026 at 8pm. Entries to be in word format only and emailed to rfs_entries@yahoo.com.au

NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.

Payment of entries: Entry fees are to be paid with entry. Entries will not be accepted without receipt of payment. Monies are to be paid to RFS account BSB 082 365 A/C 70794 2501. Receipt for payment and reference must accompany entry form. Payment on the day of judging is not accepted.

Scratchings: No refund will be given for rabbits scratched after entries have closed. All scratchings and withdrawals must be in writing to the show secretary no later than 8am on the day of judging otherwise a \$40 fine will apply to each exhibit.

Grooming: Power will be available for grooming exhibits, bring your own equipment and please clean up your own mess. No grooming to take place after judging has commenced unless permission is given by the show manager.

Vaccination: The Rabbit Fanciers Society of NSW inc highly recommends all exhibitors to vaccinate their exhibits. It is not a condition of entry. Please state on entry form or day before the show if exhibits have been recently vaccinated with Filavac, consideration by Judge will be given for small patch of missing fur, redness at injection site or small sub-cutaneous lump under the skin due to recent vaccination if stated by the exhibitor prior to the show. Under no circumstances can you identify this to the judge on the day.

Pavilion: The hall is open to the public between 9am and 5pm. Judging will start promptly at 8.30am. Only pre selected **Official Stewards** are allowed into the judging area between 8.30am and 5pm. Exhibitors may only enter the judging area if permission is given by the show manager.


Bedding: Cages will be provided on site for exhibits. Wire inserts, puppy pads and mats are recommended. No shavings, litter or straw to be used. Exhibitors must clean their pens at the end of the day, wet wipes are recommended. Cage base dimension 48x54cm. Carry cages must be placed under pens during the show. If entry numbers exceed the maximum amount of pens available then smaller exhibits will need to be in show cages to allow all exhibits to be shown.

Water and Food: Water must be available to exhibits at all times. No hay or straw to be bought to the venue. Pellets are recommended for long travelling exhibits.

The Royal Agricultural Society of NSW (RAS) General Regulations form part of the conditions of entry. The Sydney Royal Rabbit Show is held under the Rules and Regulations of the Royal Agricultural Society of New South Wales (ABN 69 793 644 351) and The Rabbit Fanciers Society Of NSW Inc (ABN 80 071 841 638). Breeds are judged under British Rabbit Council (BRC) Breed Standards and Australian National Rabbit Council (ANRCI) standards.

COLOUR GUIDE

Colour definitions – Fur, Fancy & Lop only

Red eyed white (REW) = as pure white as possible with ruby red eye colour

Ivory = (specific to Satins), eye colour red or blue

Self = black, blue, brown/chocolate/havana, lilac, blue eyed white (BEW)

Shaded = siamese sable (dark, medium or light), smoke pearl/siamese smoke, seal point, blue point, iron grey, chocolate tort, sooty fawn/tortoiseshell, beige.

Tan pattern = fox, otter and tan (in black, blue, chocolate or lilac), marten sable (light, medium or dark), smoke pearl marten (light, medium or dark)

Any other colour (AOC) = dalmation & broken pattern (in bi-colour or tri-colour), harlequin patterns, himalayan.

Agouti pattern = agouti/castor/brown grey, opal, lynx, chinchilla, cinnamon, squirrel

Any other colour (AOC) = orange, fawn, red, steel (dark, light or dark steel grey), himalayan, butterfly pattern, harlequin patterns or any other colour (not already mentioned) so long as it conforms to the normal pattern of accepted colours of other breeds excluding broken pattern.

Colour definitions – Rex & Mini Rex only

Ermine = as pure white as possible with ruby red eye colour

Self = black, blue, havana, lilac, nutria

Shaded = siamese sable, siamese smoke pearl, seal, tortoiseshell

Tan pattern = marten sable, marten seal, Smoke pearl Marten, orange (separate class), fawn, fox, otter and tan (in black, blue, choco-late or lilac)

Agouti patterned = agouti (castor), chinrex, cinnamon, lynx, opal


